Our Story

Our Purpose

Every year, hundreds of Maryland workers face life-altering injuries on the job. Tragically, on average, 60 workers lose their lives annually in these incidents. Amidst such loss and hardship, their children often find themselves grappling with uncertain futures.

Our Mission

Kids' Chance of Maryland, Inc. is dedicated to changing this narrative. Our mission is to provide financial scholarships to the children of catastrophically or fatally injured workers, empowering them to pursue their education, achieve their goals, and fulfill their dreams.

Opportunities

Unity

Kids' Chance of Maryland is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization founded by a diverse group of dedicated volunteers from Maryland's business and workers' compensation community. Our coalition includes representatives from employers, insurers, medical and vocational rehabilitation providers, as well as claimant and defense attorneys.



Removing Financial Barriers to Education

Since 1996, our 501(c)(3) nonprofit has awarded an estimated **\$3 million** in scholarships to children of Maryland's catastrophically injured workers. Backed by volunteers from Maryland's workers' compensation community, we are dedicated to helping these children achieve their dreams of higher education.

Scholarship

Which children are eligible for the scholarships? Students must have had a parent or guardian who has suffered a catastrophic or fatal accidental injury or occupational disease while working for a Maryland employer. Students must be under 25 years old to apply.

How long is this scholarship for? Scholarships are offered for one semester. Applicants must reapply at the end of each semester in order to be considered for scholarship renewal.

What does the scholarship cover? Kids' Chance of Maryland offers scholarships up to \$10,000 per semester for students whose parents were catastrophically injured or killed in workplace accidents. Scholarship awards vary and depend largely on the needs and educational expenses of the student. Scholarships cover tuition and books, but may also include housing and meals.

Eligible Student Criteria

- Must be the child of a catastrophically or fatally injured worker in Maryland.
- Must be pursuing higher education (college or trade school).
- Demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
